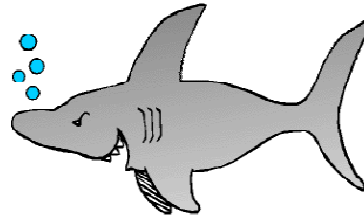
Dear Parents/Families,

Here we go! Our class is starting our fundraiser to raise the final funds needed for our field trip to the Oregon Coast Aquarium. Students are coming home today with a case of 50 candy bars – they will sell each candy bar for \$1.

Below are some guidelines for the fundraiser:

- Students are provided with an envelope to collect their money – their name should be put on it immediately. They may bring the envelope to school daily and turn in their money, or wait until they have sold a whole case.
- Students will only be given one case of candy bars at a time, unless a parent gives permission by sending in a note or calling Mrs. Cordle. For example, parents in the past have requested a second case to take to work.
- If students sell door-to-door in their neighborhood, it is important for their safety that they have a parent or older sibling go with them.
- We can accept payment by check: make checks payable to Mountain View Elementary.
- Students are to leave their case of candy bars at home (do not bring them to school to sell). We will have cases at school for on campus sales.
- When students are selling candy bars, they should ask people if they would like to help their class raise money for a field trip to the Oregon Coast Aquarium and be prepared to answer some questions about the field trip.
