

“Hands-On” Math Class/Coaching

Math Class/Coaching Goals:

- Twice a month, students will explore an Oregon math standard that has been or will be taught in the general classroom creating a double dose of the math standards.
- Math class will be an opportunity for teachers to see another teacher teach, observe their students, and collaborate with the math coach regarding the school wide math focus.
- Coaching weeks will provide teachers with a chance to have the math coach in their classroom twice a month to support math instruction.

Math Class Expectations:

- Mrs. Cordle will meet each teacher and class at the math room door – students will be welcomed to the math room and given direction.
- Observation spirals will be available if a teacher wishes to make notes in regards to things they may want to remember and/or try in their own instruction.
- When the class is with Mrs. Cordle, the teacher has a choice of how to best use this time:
 - Move around the room interacting with students – provide support when they need it
 - Sit with a team during activities
 - Sit in the back of the room as an observer
 - Collaborate with Mrs. Cordle at appropriate times
