Mrs. Cordle's 4th grade class will be going on a field trip to the Oregon Coast Aquarium on March 19th – 20th. We have been learning about marine life and are looking forward to a night with sharks and other marine animals. A marine educator will teach us about marine animals, and we will participate in an educational scavenger hunt that teaches students how to identify the fish and invertebrates. We will pitch our sleeping bags where we can see the sharks, fish, and rays circling above. In the morning, we will wake to breakfast, and a behind the scenes look at the care and feeding of the animals at the aquarium.

We will be leaving Mountain View on March 19th at 11:00 a.m. and returning to school on March 20th about 6:00 p.m. Please note that special pick up arrangements will need to be made on the 20th.
